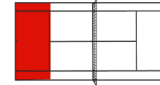


THE COURT

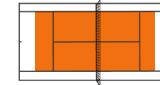
COURT SIZES in feet

Red Court



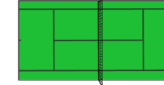
36' x 18'

Orange Court



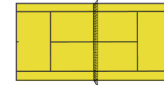
60' x 27' Singles

Green Court

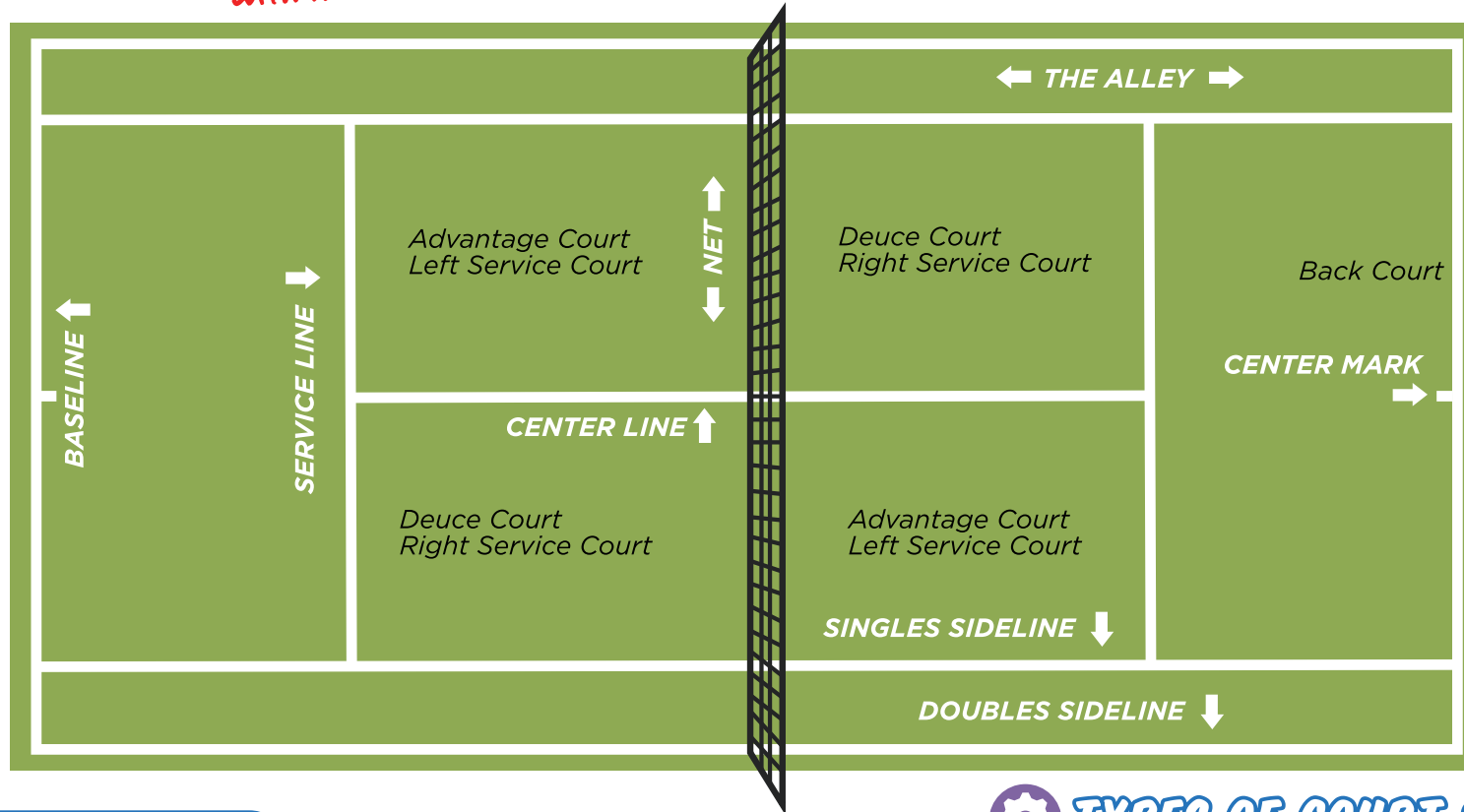


78' x 27' Singles

There are 3 feet in 1 yard.
To convert feet to yards the calculation is:
Number of Feet ÷ 3 = Yards

FAMOUS COURTS

Centre Court Wimbledon in London is the worlds most famous **GRASS** court. The Australian and U.S. Opens play on **SYNTHETIC** blue courts. The French Open is famous for its **CLAY** surface.



TYPES OF COURT SURFACE

■ CLAY

Can slide and produce different bounces on dry or wet surfaces.

■ GRASS

Bounce depends on grass length, low bounces keep rallies short.

■ HARD

Vary in speed, greater play consistency.

■ SYNTHETIC

Fast play, consistent bounce, added sand can slow play.
