

DOMINANT SIDE

First do all the tests yourself. Ask volunteers to help you complete the experiments and you can tell them your findings.

You must give each volunteer the instructions and then observe carefully what they do. Record the answers for each experiment below.

HANDS

1. Ask your volunteer to write their name on paper. Give them the ball and ask them to throw it a target. *Which hand did they use for each task?*



FEET

Place a coin on the floor and ask the volunteer to step on it. *Which foot did they use?*



EYES

Give your volunteer the empty tube and ask them to look at a distant object. *Which eye did they put the tube to?*



EARS

Hand your volunteer the seashell or phone and ask them to listen to it. *Which ear did they put it to?*
