TENNIS MAJORS

U.S. OPEN September
Hard court tournament played in New York. It was the first grand slam to hold night matches. In 1975 became the first Grand Slam tourney to have night games.

AUSTRALIAN OPEN January
Kicks off the Grand Slam series in Melbourne. Played on a hardcourt surface. The longest Grand Slam final was at the Australian Open between Novak Djokovic and Rafael Nadal in 2012. Djokovic won.

WIMBLEDON June/July
Played on grass, it is the oldest tennis competition in the world and is regarded as the most prestigious of the Grand Slams. Wimbledon has a strict dress code that players must be dressed in white.

FRENCH OPEN May/June
Held in Paris, it is the only Grand Slam played on clay courts. In 1968, it became the first Grand Slam to allow professionals and amateurs to compete together, now called an "open" tournament.
